**Flower Show Competition Schedule**

Saturday, February 18, 2017

**Theme: Happy 150<sup>th</sup> Birthday Canada!**  
**Celebrating Canada in all Seasons**

- Class 1     **Summer Lake**— a water-viewing design – a line design in an open shallow container, with 2/3 to 3/4 of container surface showing clear water. Space allotted: 18” wide x 18” deep.
- Class 2     **Fall Fireworks** – a design. Space allotted: 18” wide x 18” deep.
- Class 3     **Spring Party** – a design to resemble a cake or a slice of cake.
- Class 4     **Winter Warmer**— a planter – a grouping of growing plants artistically arranged in one container. Space allotted: 24” wide x 24” deep.
- Class 5A    *Junior Class – age 10 and under only*  
              **Maple Leaf** – a design to depict our national flag. Not to exceed 12” in length or width.
- Class 5B    *Junior Class - age 11 to 16 only*  
              **Maple Leaf** – a design to depict our national flag. Not to exceed 12” in length or width.

**RULES**

1. All members of Horticultural Societies and Garden Clubs in Ontario, students of the Floral Design Program at the TBG, and any other interested non-professional floral designers are invited to enter. Exhibitors may enter any number of classes, but may submit only one exhibit per class. **Please Note** that while we encourage those under 17 to enter the junior classes, they may also enter any of the other classes.
2. Entries will be received on Friday, February 17, 2017, between 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon, and Saturday, February 18, 2017, between 8:00 a.m. and 9:15 a.m. in Studio 1, on the Upper Level of the TBG.
3. Each entry must be accompanied by a completed entry tag (to be supplied). Please include a file card with the names of all plant material used for Class 4.
4. Plant material used in all classes may be newly acquired. No artificial plant material may be used. Any fresh cut plant material must be in water or water-retaining material.
5. Accessories are permitted in all classes.
6. The standard for judging will be the *Ontario Judging and Exhibiting Standards for Horticulture and Floral Design, 2003 Edition*. The entries will be judged by an accredited judge(s).
7. Entries must remain in place until 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, February 18, 2017. All exhibits must be removed by 4:30 p.m.
